

PSBB Triumphs at Inter School Math Fest – KKN

It has become a habit of PSBBians to win in every competition that they participate. This time was no different- our school won an array of awards to lift the Ramanujan Cup at the recently concluded math competition conducted by PS Senior Secondary School, Mylapore.

The event drew participation from 200 students spanning 30 city schools conducted for students of Classes VI – X included Online Rapid Fire Math Test, Model Making, Poster design using Math symbols, Maths Quiz and Maths Talent Test. Almost all the students who represented our school returned with prizes.

In the math modelling event, a model was made showing the application of coordinate geometry in the functioning of GPS to track its location accurately. The team comprising R. Nikil and T.V.Raghavasimhan, class 10, bagged the second place from more than 25 models at display. There were many other interesting models showcased by other schools- using trigonometry to calculate heights, the best possible structure of a bridge to avoid a collapse, and a model of an advanced walking stick for the disabled .

The math quiz contained 40 questions involving the historical and logical aspects of math.



Around 60-70 teams participated in the quiz, and the team from our school, consisting of Gurunathan and Suraj (class 9) competing with students from classes 9, 10, 11 and 12, performed commendably and got the third prize. Moreover, they finished the quiz in 22 minutes, though they were given an hour and were the second team to complete the quiz.

Harish V & S. Shreya (Std 6) representing our school in the Poster making competition also did a fabulous job, and won the 2nd place. Their logo (of the Ramanujam's Cup) was also displayed on stage during the awards ceremony along with those of the other prize winning schools. Sanjeev VA and U.K.Arvidan (Std 8) bagged the 2nd place in the Math talent test, but the results of the online test have not yet been announced.
