

Trip to DakshinaChitra

Students of class 6 and class 4 of PSBB T. Nagar were taken on a field trip to Dakshinachitra, an art and craft village of South India located on ECR Road .DakshinaChitra was celebrating their “VasanthaVizha” at that time, a festival especially designed for school children.

Students were exposed to the architectural style of the houses of the Southern States- Tamilnadu, Kerala, Karnataka, Andrapradesh and Telangana. Each house represented the architecture of that particular region and also illustrated the life – style of the people who lived in them. The houses also had exhibits which included items of everyday use like utensils used for cooking, furniture, indoor games, art etc.,. The significance of each house was explained briefly to the students by a tour-guide.

Students also enjoyed watching a cultural programme on folk dance of Utrakhand Karagattam – Tamilnadu folk and a puppet and magic show. They also viewed the various stalls which sold handicraft items made by the folk-artists of the South Indian villages.
