Students of PSBB T.Nagar qualified for National Finale of Wild Wisdom Quiz held on 6th October at New Delhi. 15 schools across the country participated in the National Finals and 5 teams qualified for the FINALE along with one team from Nepal. The school team represented by Shrivats Gopal of VII B and Dhananjay Krishnan of VII C got the 4th position. The Quiz was conducted by the famous Quiz Master Mr Siddharth Basu.

The students had an opportunity to stay at Camp Hornbill at Ram Nagar, near Jim Corbett National Park. It was a very fascinating experience. The whole show was run by wildlife veterans and villagers. They learnt a few skills like sleeping in tents, making their own beds

etc. Most importantly, they learnt to live in harmony with nature: water consumption and electricity consumption were regulated. The guides knew the forest inside-out and could identify more than hundred species of plants, insects, animals and birds. They also stressed the importance of eco-tourism and stated that the development of posh and sophisticated resorts caused many problem for different species of animals and birds. It was an extraordinary experience for the students.
