FilmIt engages students (classes 6-8) in developing short films (1 to 2 minutes) on their culture that can be shared through the internet with school children in the UK.

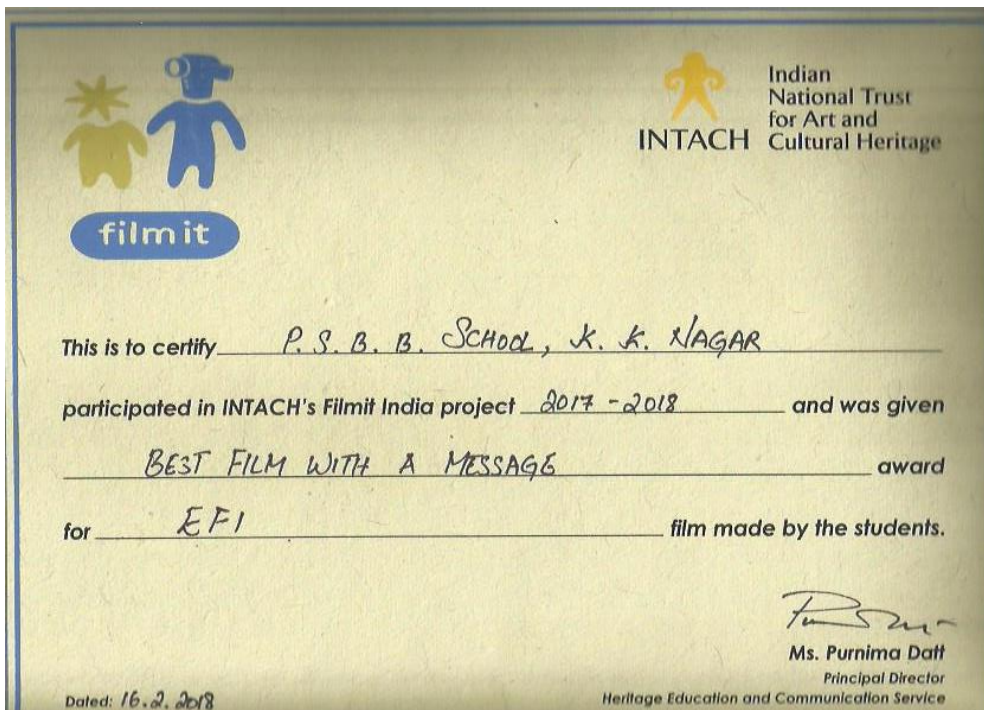

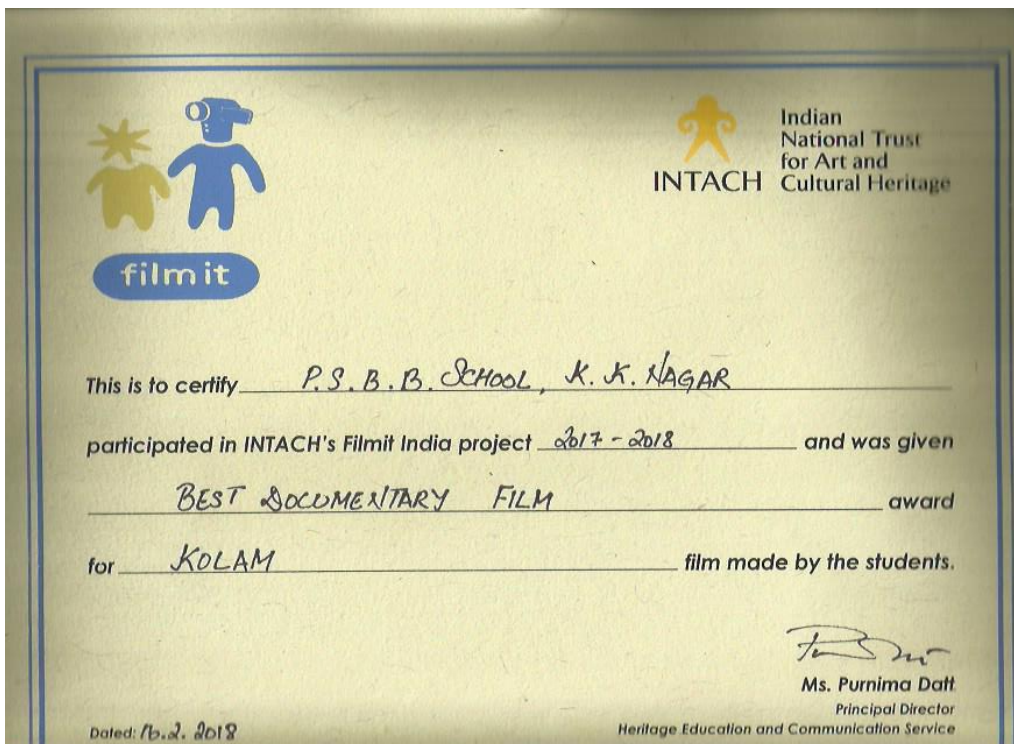
