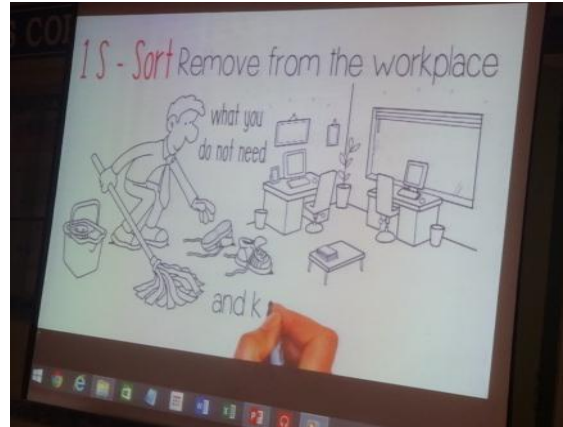


THE JAPANESE SECRET TO SUCCESS – with 5S!
