

## Library week celebrations

The Library week celebrations at PSBB - T. Nagar for the year 2018-19 included a cauldron of activities for classes Pre KG to VIII.

Students of PKG, LKG and UKG enjoyed a story telling session by Mrs. Sharanya Mohan, which was replete with props and animations. Class I students had to pick their favourite character with the help of the clues given.



Class 2 students were asked to draw their favourite comic character, name it and write a line about why they liked the character. They thoroughly enjoyed this creative activity.

The students of class 3 had an interesting Snake and Ladder activity in which they had to coin new words with the two letter words given on the left and right of the ladder. The challenge was to include a common letter in the middle to make meaningful words. The imagination of the students of class 4 came to the fore with beautiful and colourful illustrations from the poem “The Caterpillar and the butterfly”. Important lines of the poem corresponding to the illustration were displayed in the form of speech bubbles.



A quiz on books, characters, titles and authors was conducted for students of class 5. Class 6 students had to do a crossword on books, characters and authors.
