Mr.Prathik speaks fluent English, Sanskrit, Tamil and Hindi and is a popular speaker on Doordarshan and various radio FM channels. He works for a famous NGO and is an authority on our culture and tradition.

Mr. Prathik began his speech by explaining how history defines our identity, corrects mistakes of the past, satisfies curiosity, helps understand architecture and learn good things from the past and develop it.
