Parliamentary Debate for debaters under 15 organised by the Oxford and Cambridge Union. She is also a part of Team India Orange for the year 2022.

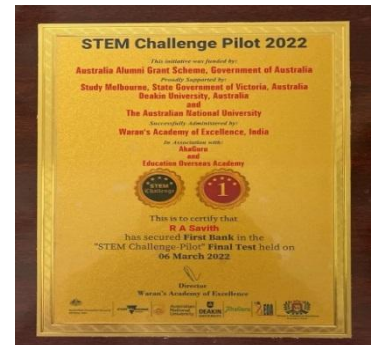


## Conquering the STEM

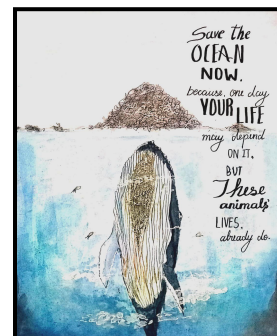
shield and a cash prize of Rs.25, 000.
