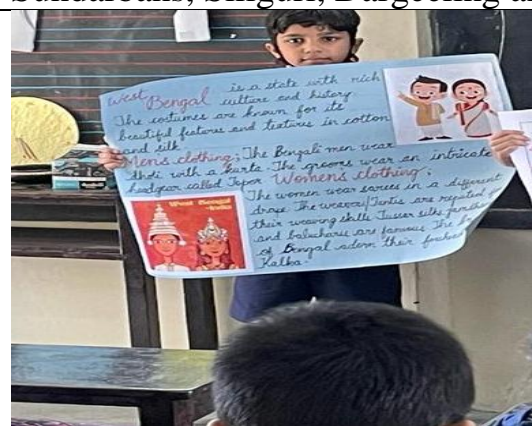
“Nomoshkar friends, Come with us to a tour of West Bengal!”
