

Science Day Celebrations

Science Day was celebrated at PSBB, T. Nagar on 28th February 2023, commemorating the National Science Day, celebrated in India every year to mark the discovery of the Raman effect by Sir CV Raman.

Dr. P. Santhi (Professor from Agriculture University of Tamilnadu) was the Chief Guest and the theme was the 'International Year of Millets'. The main objective was to create awareness about including millets in our daily diet.

The agenda included presentation on the importance of UN theme on millets and highlights of the month long science day celebrations at school by students from KG to class 8.
